Bus Services COVID-19 Update and Expectations



Following the COVID-19 lockdown, we have reviewed our bus services and processes based on the most up-to-date guidance issued by the UK government, including guidance from the Department for Education.

Our priority is to keep pupils and staff safe. To this end we have identified a range of measures that we have put in place for our bus services from September.

New Booking System

We have introduced a new booking system in partnership with Vectare. All regular bus users and parents of new pupils who have indicated that they require a bus pass have been pre-loaded onto the system. This will help us manage the bus services and give a clear indication of availability of seats for new pass holders and ad hoc users who wish to purchase individual journeys.

Regular and new bus pass holders will be emailed confirmation of their booking and details of how to set up and manage their account and claim their booking by going to <https://princethorpe.vectare.co.uk>.

As well as availability, the site shows clear information on all bus routes, stops and fare information.

From September 2020 onwards those wishing to book a bus pass or individual journeys will need to do so on the system. This will ensure there are enough seats for us to operate our bus services in line with the government's safer transport guidelines. All ad hoc users must pre-book a seat to travel. A £10 penalty fare will be charged per journey for those who fail to do so.

Those wishing to book a new pass or ad hoc users can set up an account, check availability and book a pass or individual tickets on the system as they require. These bookings will be added to the next termly fee invoice.

All pass holders will be issued with a bus pass at the start of term. Those booking individual journeys must download a booking confirmation for each journey on to their mobile phone to show when boarding or alighting the bus.

New Operational Measures

All school bus routes will be operating with the following new control measures in place:

- From September to minimise congestion and aid social distancing arrivals and departures of the bus services will be split between the main drive and the back lane of the College. Four services, the S1, S5, S8 and S12 will continue to use the bus bay at the front of school, the remaining eight services will access the back lane from the Coventry Road. Some of these services will need to travel up to the roundabout at Rytton on the A423 in order to approach and access the College safely from the north. We hope this move will also bring benefits from a traffic management point of view, easing some congestion on the drive and in Princethorpe village.
- Thorough cleaning will take place on all buses before and after each school run.
- Pupils must act responsibly at bus stops and on the bus e.g. maintaining social distance in queues, when boarding and alighting.
- Pupils are required to use the hand sanitiser provided when they enter and exit the bus.
- Masks or face coverings must be worn at all times. Please contact Mrs Sharpe – Deputy Head - Pastoral if you have any concerns or queries relation to this requirement.
- Where small enough school bags should be kept on laps, larger bags or instruments should be stored in the luggage areas beneath the bus.
- Seats will be zoned on the buses based on year group and pupils must sit with other pupils in their year group zone to maintain their bubble.

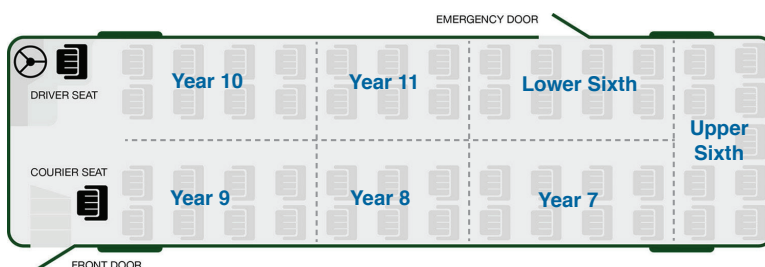
It is important that parents also play their part in keeping everybody safe:

- If your child shows any symptoms of COVID-19 they MUST NOT travel on the school bus services or attend school.
- If your child is self-isolating as a result of COVID-19 symptoms or sharing a household or support bubble with somebody with symptoms they MUST NOT travel on the school bus services, or attend school.
- Parents are asked to check carefully for any symptoms before their child leaves home, including taking their temperature each morning as a way of further reducing risk, noting that some people can have COVID-19 but remain asymptomatic.

We will be taking these measures very seriously and monitoring CCTV, feedback from pupils and our bus providers to ensure pupils adhere to these Health and Safety expectations. Failure to do so is likely to result in withdrawal of right to use the bus services.

The College has worked closely with our bus operators who are committed to following this new protocol from September. We will continue to monitor any changes announced by the Government. We will keep you informed should we need to make any adjustments to these protocols in order that we continue to ensure the safety of pupils and staff.

Bus Briefing 2020-2021

Our Bus Services

A comprehensive private bus service brings pupils into the College from a wide area, extending as far afield as Burbage, Nuneaton and Coventry to the north, Lutterworth and Daventry to the east, Stratford-upon-Avon and Banbury to the south and Solihull and Henley-in-Arden to the west.

Around half of the school population use the services across twelve routes, which are operated by Catteralls of Southam and Riddleys of Leamington. All of their drivers are child safeguarding and first aid trained, and where possible regular drivers operate the routes.

We are constantly monitoring our services and looking for improvements. We welcome feedback and suggestions to buses@princethorpe.co.uk.

Safety

The safety of pupils using the bus service is of paramount importance.

We ask parents to talk to their children about how to keep safe going to and from the bus stop and ensure they know what to do if the bus doesn't arrive. There is a briefing for pupils who use the bus service at the start of each academic year.

The College's risk assessment of the bus service is published on *My School Portal* and is sent out via *The Flagpole* at the start of each academic year and whenever changes are made.

Expectations of pupils

We expect all bus users to behave with maturity, courtesy and respect whilst travelling to and from school. Pupils must stay seated and wear seat belts at all times. Bags should be safely out of the aisle and not on seats; larger bags must be stored in the boot or hold. Sixth Form pupils act as supervisors on buses and should be listened to and obeyed.

Unacceptable behaviour on the buses is deemed very serious. Pupils will be excluded from using buses if their behaviour does not meet the expected standards.

Bus passes

Bus passes are issued during the first week of term. Pupils may simply board the bus in the first week of the year, as long as bus fares have been paid. Thereafter, all bus users will need to show a valid pass or a mobile confirmation instead of ticket.

Our bus team are in attendance each morning and evening to ensure safety. Bus passes and ticket confirmations are checked as buses arrive and in the evening before buses are boarded.

Bus passes should be shown for every journey, failure to produce a pass on five occasions will lead to a replacement pass being automatically issued at a cost of £10, which will be added to the school bill.

Unless we have heard to the contrary, for existing pupils, we have assumed that stops used last year will continue for the coming year. Where services are provided by different buses we have migrated the information.

Please note: Half a term's notice is required for the cancellation of a bus pass. Please email buses@princethorpe.co.uk to notify us.

We reserve the right to impose a penalty fare if there is frequent non-compliance on the part of a specific individual who is unable to show a valid pass or ticket. Defaced passes will be confiscated and replaced automatically at a cost of £10.

Sibling discount

Discounts are applied to bus passes only for siblings (10% for second and 50% for third and subsequent siblings) whilst there are two or more children holding bus passes.

Individual tickets

Individual tickets for single fares should be booked online at <https://princethorpe.vectare.co.uk>. Pupils should download confirmation on to their mobile phones. All adhoc tickets must be pre-booked in advance. Failure to do so will result in a £10 penalty charge for each journey being added to the next term's bill.

Changes to Services 2020

This information applies to bus services with effect from Tuesday 1 September 2020.

There have been small changes to a few routes which are outlined below.

Service S3

Will continue on current timings until new roadworks are complete.

Service S4

New Burbage stop added at start of route.

Bulkington - The New Inn stop replaced by Rugby Road/Arden Road stop.

Service S8

Flecknoe stop now AM and PM.

Service S10

Gilmorton stop reinstated due to full bus pass being purchased.

North Kilworth stop AM and PM now.

NOTE: We currently have four stops in operation as bus passes have been purchased at the start/end of a route. These are:

- S4 Burbages stops
- S6 Waitrose AM and PM
- S10 North Kilworth and Gilmorton

Should circumstances change the College reserves the right to suspend any of these stops until such time as further passes are purchased.

The S10 and S11 also have stops towards the start of the route which are in grey to indicate these are currently suspended, but can be reinstated if a single or return bus pass is purchased.

The timetable

Services are of course subject to conditions which are sometimes out of our control, such as roadworks, accidents or the great British weather.

We will alert parents about delays or roadworks via email or text messages, so please update your account on Vectare if your child starts using a different stop. You can also follow the Bus Twitter account @Pcbuses for updates and news.

Broadly speaking the buses operate to time, however the nationally adopted standard is a tolerance of one minute early to five minutes late, so pupils need to be standing at stops within this six-minute window and be ready to board the bus. Timings may vary due to traffic conditions or unforeseen circumstances. Drivers will not wait past the scheduled departure time.

Advice to pupils - If your bus is late in the morning

- Wait 20 minutes – then the most senior student at the stop should ring the bus company:
Catteralls of Southam Tel 01926 813840 or 07917 121591;
Ridleys of Leamington Spa Tel 01926 430130
(These numbers are in the homework diary)
- If the bus does not arrive when the company says it will, ring school, 01926 634200 - you will be told what to do.
- Always wait at the bus stop – if a bus breaks down it can take up to an hour to organise a replacement.

DO NOT go back home unless told to do so by school.

Advice to pupils - After school

All buses leave at the end of the school day and depart at 3.55pm prompt. See new operational measures on page 2.

Always take the correct route and follow instructions from members of staff when getting to your bus. It can be very busy with cars, so please take care and stay safe.

Arrangements need to be made for collection of those children staying on for co-curricular activities until 5.15pm or Princethorpe Prep until 6.00pm.
